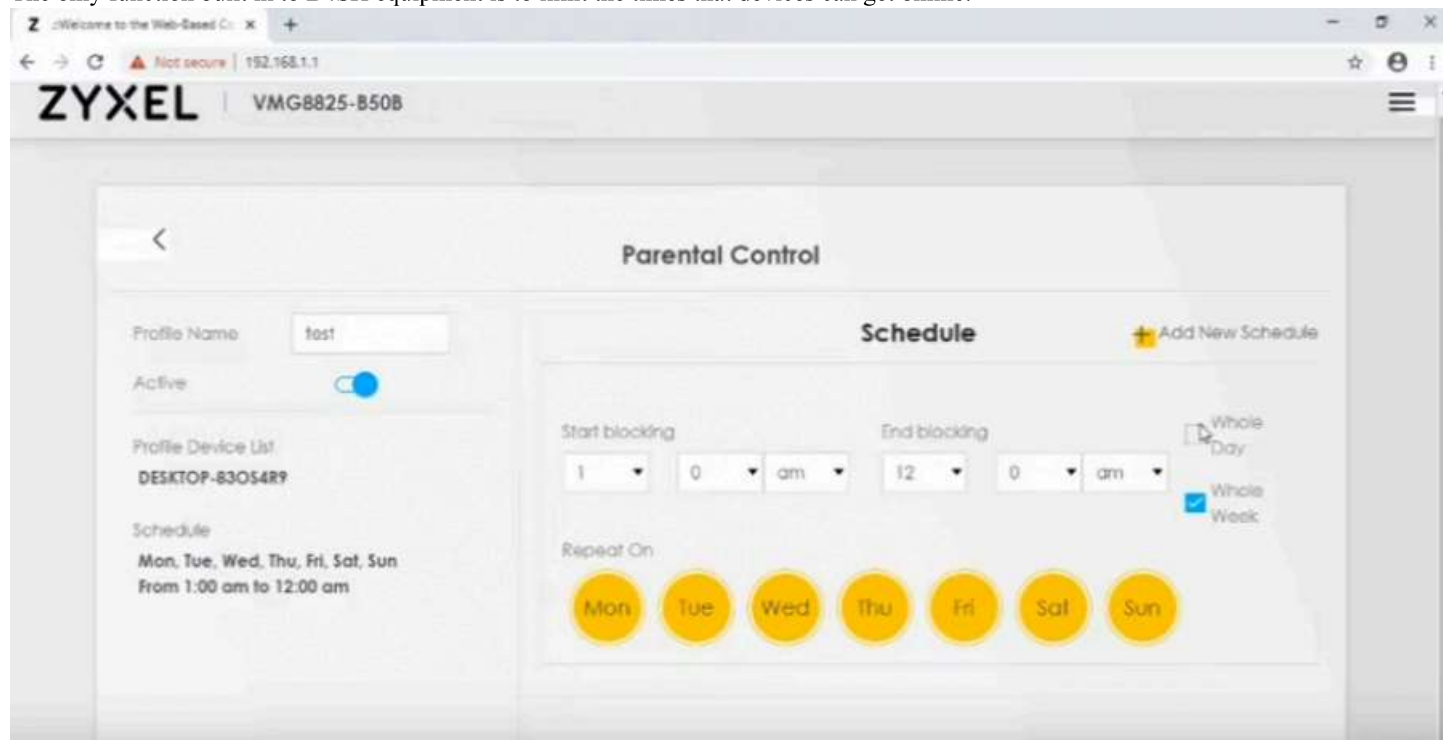


Parental Controls

From B4SH technotes

Note: Both of these methods settings will get lost if someone factory resets the router. Depending on technical capability of your child there are many ways around parental control systems. Privacy or VPN browsers are the most likely method to evade blocks. Manually setting DNS on their device would also avoid the block. If they know the routers admin login (if you don't change it) they would also be able to log into the router and turn the settings back off.

The only function built in to B4SH equipment is to limit the times that devices can get online:



To access this function log into the router (default at <http://192.168.1.1>) and go to the 3 lines menu icon top right:



Then to Security -- Parental Control.

The other more granular option would be to force your network to use OpenDNS Family Shield nameservers which can't do timed internet access but will block adult sites (for every device in the house):

To change this on the B4SH Zyxel router log in to the routers admin interface (default at <http://192.168.1.1>).

Go to the 3 lines menu icon top right:



Then Network Settings, Broadband Click the edit button on the "SFPWAN" line or (if that isn't present the "ETHWAN" line). Find the DNS server line and change it to "Use Following Static DNS Address"
